Resolution on Migrant Protection and Overseas Employment Transparency*(Submitted by Ijaz, PLC Saudi Arabia Chapter)*

Whereas, it is observed that a significant number of Indian citizens who travel abroad for employment and education continue to face exploitation, deception, and violation of their rights in several foreign countries;

Whereas, although the Government of India has initiated measures to regulate the recruitment process, ensure transparency, and provide legal assistance to migrant workers, the practical implementation of these measures remains inadequate;

Whereas, many Indian Embassies and Consulates do not effectively intervene in employment-related disputes faced by Indian workers abroad, resulting in denial of wages, benefits, and fair redress to several migrants;

Whereas, legal and administrative actions against recruiting agencies involved in fraud or malpractice are often delayed or not effectively enforced;

Whereas, it is essential to strengthen awareness among migrant workers about their legal rights and to establish mechanisms through the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) for prompt and coordinated response to issues affecting Indian citizens overseas;

Therefore, this General Body Meeting of the Pravasi Legal Cell (PLC) Kerala Chapter resolves as follows:

1. The PLC Kerala Chapter urges the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, to ensure effective implementation of transparent and accountable recruitment practices; to define clear responsibility for Indian Embassies and Consulates in protecting migrant workers' welfare and labour rights; and to impose strict legal action, including blacklisting, against recruiting agencies found guilty of exploitation or fraud.
2. The Ministry should establish an efficient monitoring and redressal mechanism to provide legal assistance, awareness programmes, and emergency support to migrant workers both in India and abroad in coordination with the concerned missions and State authorities.
3. This resolution, proposed by the Pravasi Legal Cell Saudi Arabia Chapter, is hereby unanimously adopted by the Pravasi Legal Cell Kerala Chapter Annual
